Education should not be halted

Thousands of university students are forced to quit their studies each year due to an inability to meet their basic needs. Our scholarship interviews reveal that three out of every five students face the risk of quitting their education. Following the February 6 earthquakes in 2023, we received more than 107 thousand scholarship applications. We acknowledge the difficulties faced by all students in our country because of this catastrophe and we continue to support our young people by ensuring that their education continues under any circumstance.

In this regard, in addition to the scholarships we provided to help students directly affected by the disaster continue their education, we also contributed in every other way available to us, such as aiding in the construction of schools in the earthquake region, and supporting distance learning. By transforming our collaborations into communication campaigns that are highly visible in the national media, we further encouraged social sensitivity towards these young people in the region, keeping them on the agenda. Guided by our deeprooted values, healing the wounds of our young people with kindness will be our priority in the upcoming period.

As an exemplary non-governmental organization that, thanks to its successful efforts, has earned a notable reputation among communities and noteworthy trust among all its stakeholders, TEV conducted significant initiatives for the future in 2023.

During the reporting period, we raised the number of grantees while improving our capabilities and capacity to generate sustainable value for society. At TEV, our efforts in many areas - ranging from corporate governance to digitalization, and from fund-raising to stakeholder communication – resulted in numerous other concrete outputs during the period. In the awareness that strong corporate governance is key to ensuring the sustainability of our efforts for society, we are implementing models in this area. In 2023, we elevated our Corporate Governance Rating to 9.72, once again confirming the importance we attribute to corporate governance principles.

The projects we developed for the solid future of our country, and our communication efforts to convey our messages to society in the most effective way possible, have garnered significant accolades during the year.

Following our decision to reopen a preparatory class, TEVITÖL welcomed 82 more students for the 2023-24 academic year. In 2023, the average scholarship rate rose to 65% at TEVITÖL, where 99 out of 279 students received a scholarship of 90% or more. As a result of the reintroduction of a preparatory class to our school, in which we support more families in need with higher scholarship rates, and with the positive impact of those increased scholarship rates, the percentage of students enrolled in the High School Entrance Examination in 2023 also improved significantly compared to the previous year. In 2023, TEVITÖL students continued to make us proud with their academic, social and cultural achievements, as well as the awards they received.

In the past year, TEVİTÖL's physics, chemistry and biology laboratories were renovated and an Advisory Board, chaired by Prof. Üstün Ergüder, was established, further improving the quality of education for Türkiye's bright youth.

MESSAGE FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

As TEV, we have been working for 56 years to ensure access to quality education, a fundamental human right and a key to sustainable development.

Esteemed TEV Members and Education Fellows,

As TEV, we have been working for 56 years to ensure access to quality education, one of the most fundamental human rights and a key to sustainable development. In 2023, with the awareness and responsibility of contributing to the modern future of our country, we carried out projects that touched the lives of our youth.

Since our establishment, we have built 32 educational facilities across Türkiye. Providing 284 thousand scholarships in Türkiye, we also supported nearly 2,300 young people in their higher education and doctoral studies abroad. We support the housing needs of grantees by means of our girls' dormitories in Ankara, Izmir and Trabzon. Through our 13 TEV branches in 13 provinces, we maintain fund-raising efforts, address the needs of our will and grant benefactors, and support our grantees in every aspect.

We took action to provide longterm and sustainable support to young people who have been profoundly affected by disasters.

Although 2023 was an immensely challenging year, the sorrow caused by the February 6 earthquakes again demonstrated the importance of solidarity and civil society. While one out of every five students in primary education was affected by this tragedy we, as the Foundation, utilized resources for our grantees who were victims of the earthquakes and for all young people affected by the disaster.

In this regard, we provided an additional TL 3 million in housing scholarship support to 2,525 grantees residing or who have families residing in the provinces affected by the earthquake. In addition, we provided approximately TL 2 million to 1,300 students studying in the disaster area and/or whose families are in this region and who did not qualify for scholarships in the 2022-2023 academic year. We provided computer support to approximately 1,000 young people who required technology access after the transition to distance education due to the earthquakes. We announced applications for four-month scholarships for newly admitted university students affected by the earthquake in the first degree. We provided scholarships to 1,275 students whose family members were deceased or injured, or whose homes were destroyed. We also started to build schools in Adıyaman and Hatay through our School Bell Fund and began rebuilding dreams together.

We established scholarship funds, including Don't Give Up on School, On the Way to School, and We Will Return, for young people who are at risk of giving up on their education due to the earthquakes. We established important collaborations with numerous education-friendly organizations to support our youth, especially via scholarship funds; and we worked with a wide range of media outlets in our communication activities, to draw public attention to the earthquake-affected region. We went beyond providing mere financial support to our students and strived to understand their needs for the future and support their emotional well-being and fulfillment. To solidify our impact on the lives of students, we prioritize collaborations with Türkive's leading companies and brands to produce strong outputs that include mentorships, internships and job opportunities.

In the 100th anniversary of our Republic, we worked with greater responsibility for a brighter tomorrow.

In 2023, as our Republic - the indestructible foundation of our national unity and solidarity - turns 100 years old, we elevated our efforts to ensure that the spirit, principles and values of the Republic will live forever by following in the footsteps of our Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk.

Together with our esteemed donors and grantees, we celebrated the Republic's centennial at a dedicated event. We prepared a special campaign movie for this momentous year, calling for support on behalf of our youth and our future with the slogan "May they study, may they be the future of the Republic."

We recognize that the path to a brighter future in the next century of our Republic lies in growing the value created by our women. We accord the utmost importance to our female students and, to ensure that these students are provided with the means to evolve into strong individuals, supporting their education is one of our top priorities. In 2023, our National Athlete Şahika Ercümen broke the world record in the nonpallet variable weight category in Yayladağı, Hatay, in a demonstration intended to support the education of female students, especially those affected by the earthquake. By way of the campaign titled "Breathe Life into Hatay," we aimed to provide assistance to 100 young women receiving training in sports.

We celebrated this special year with our executives and TEV stakeholders at an exciting event. Our benefactors had the opportunity to listen in person to the inspiring stories of our grantees and alumni and, additionally, Erol Evgin, the maestro of Turkish pop music, presented us with an unforgettable night of his songs. During the year, we also organized a special concert for the 100th anniversary of our Republic, hosted by our Izmir Branch. The event was opened by the TEV Volunteers Support for Education

So far, we have provided approximately 284 thousand scholarships in Türkiye and supported nearly 2,300 young people in their graduate studies abroad.

Within its scope, we signed a protocol with the Ankara Metropolitan Municipality in 2023 and thus our capital city joined this civil support movement for young people.

The Turkish Education Foundation Inanç Türkeş Private High School (TEVİTÖL) has completed three decades of supporting bright children by offering them opportunities to realize themselves and achieve their dreams. Our school continues to raise scientifically, academically, and culturally knowledgeable, pioneering individuals who are likely to create an impact on society, thanks to its focused curriculum designed for students with high potential, as well as its multifaceted extracurricular activities and student clubs. In 2023, TEVİTÖL students once again honored us with their outstanding achievements in Türkiye and abroad.

2023 will always be a special year in the corporate history of our Foundation.

For more than half a century, we have been committed to equal opportunity in education. In addition, we see it as our social responsibility to conduct a corporate governance process following international standards. In 2023, Kobirate International Credit Rating and Corporate Governance Services raised TEV's Corporate Governance Compliance Rating to 9.72, which is the clearest indicator that our Foundation is being managed with a fair, transparent, accountable and responsible approach towards all its stakeholders. Last year, we also began to share the results of our value creation journey in a multidimensional way through our first Integrated Annual Report.

We have been witnessing a major technological transformation around digitalization in all areas of life. As TEV, we seek to benefit from the opportunities offered by digitalization throughout our value chain and to lead this transformation process, which is also a cultural transition, in our field. In 2023, we continued to be recognized by prominent organizations for our achievements in line with our ideal of a modern country. We received a total of 14 awards at the MediaCat Felis, Brandverse, and Effie Awards for our communication activities aimed at elevating the visibility of projects such as "Whose Backpack Is This?" HISTORY

TEV was established in May 1967 by 205 founding members led by Vehbi Koç to support the education of successful students who need financial support.

TEV was established in May 1967 by 205 founding members led by Vehbi Koç. Goals of the foundation were stated as follows: "To provide scholarships to successful students who need financial support, to build student dormitories, centers and similar institutions, to make allocations to raise the productivity of the establishments founded, to organize awards to promote students' studies and to conduct scientific research on education."

In 1967, an announcement with the heading "Call of the Turkish Education Foundation to the Turkish Nation" was published in newspapers. The text, starting with "The Turkish Education Foundation which has completed its preparations and has come into operation, considers it an honor to announce the following issues to the Turkish public" consisted of nine items. The following items described general principles and goals along with the reason for its existence:

1. It has now been understood that the acceleration of economic development is only possible with a rise in gualified manpower committed to the homeland. Education is the only key for qualified manpower. Education in Türkiye does not develop at a rate and speed that will ensure rapid development and meet population growth. For this reason, apart from the development lagging behind, our young people who want to receive education but cannot afford it, and our raw values disappear every year.

- 2. Providing education is the duty of the state. However, we believe is destined to develop rapidly, it is the duty of those who have the opportunity to help the state and ago in most of the developed is frequently made in education. That's why the Turkish Education Foundation has been established to make this contribution.
- 3. The goals of the foundation are to provide scholarships to successful students who need financial support, to build student dormitories, centers, and similar institutions, to make allocations to raise the productivity of the establishments founded, to organize awards to promote students' studies and to conduct scientific research on education.

The Turkish Education Foundation serves to contribute to the achievement of SKA 4 (Quality Education) and SKA 5 (Gender Equality) targets.

Quality Education & Gender Equality

The Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations consist of 17 items that contribute to the sustainability of the world. Each item set aims to contribute to the wellbeing of the individual and the planet where we live, in different fields. Public institutions, private organizations, and nongovernmental organizations as the third sector, all of which are the actors of this field, either perform activities in line with these goals determined by the UN or organize their activities in a way that contributes to the attainment of these goals. The Turkish Education Foundation serves to contribute to the achievement of SKA 4 (Quality Education) and SKA 5 (Gender Equality) targets.

Financial support for the access of students to qualified education is the primary scope of the Foundation. Other than the scholarship support provided to avoid the interruption of students' education, the different contents, which will contribute to their educational lives, are developed as well. Online training, seminars, mentoring, and internship support are offered to enable students to tap into their development. With the activities carried out as part of these headings, it is aimed to give additional support to the university education the students had and to help them be integrated into the business life smoothly after their educational life. Secondly, the Foundation attaches importance to gender equality. Insights and experiences obtained from the scholarship interviews indicate that girls and young women are disadvantaged in accessing education.

The Foundation carries out activities to play a role in achieving such goals. With the scholarship funds it has formed for individuals and institutions, the Foundation offers benefactors the chance to make conditional donations. The scholarship funds system also provides the opportunity for conditional donations to the benefactors who want to donate only to female students. Moreover, in the projects launched especially in collaboration with institutions, the paramount condition may require participants to be predominantly female students.

Thanks to the special measures taken to encourage girls and young women to have an education, 56% of our vocational high school grantees and 57% of our university grantees are female.

CORPORATE GOVERNANCE ACTIVITIES

The Turkish Education Foundation kept working as a reputable and fruitful non-governmental organization of Türkiye also in 2023, with its more than fifty years of experience and within the framework of the values that shed light on its working principle and involve all of its activities.

Awareness of people and society, accountability, transparency, commitment to the law, and focus on change and development were applied in all fields of the works grounded on the code of ethics and working principles. Some of the governance practices introduced to give depth to efforts within the framework of these values, and to take action more rapidly are as follows.

A- Corporate Governance Rating Report

For 56 years, TEV has been devoted to promoting equal opportunities in education, while at the same time maintaining a transparent, accountable, and internationally recognized corporate governance process.

The Foundation raised its score to 9.72 this year in the "Corporate Governance Compliance Rating" survey conducted by Kobirate International Credit Rating and Corporate Governance Services, an independent and impartial organization, of which the Foundation was included for the first time last year. In the research, corporate governance performances are evaluated under four main categories: 'Shareholders', 'Public Disclosure and Transparency', 'Stakeholders', and 'Board of Directors'.

B- Committees and Working Groups

Highlights from the Domestic **Scholarship Practices:**

- For the 2022-2023 academic year, scholarship quotas were allocated to 689 faculties of 119 state universities and colleges in 81 provinces, as well as Vocational High Schools, and about 13,000 students, including 201 TEVİTÖL students and international grantees received scholarships.
- For the 2022-2023 academic year, approximately 43,000 students applied for the education (higher education) scholarship of TEV, and following pre-selection, 30,005 students were invited for interview.

- A team of approximately 80 TEV General Directorate and branch managers participated in the selection of scholarship recipients in the fall semester of the 2022-2023 academic year with faculty members from 689 faculties in 81 provinces across Türkiye, ensuring that the selection process was conducted according to the TEV scholarship criteria.

TEV's support to students after the Maraş Earthquake centered in Pazarcık on February 6, 2023

- The day after the February 6, 2023 earthquakes, 2,573 grantees of the Foundation in the affected region were immediately identified through the system, and a TEV team of 35 employees from TEV branches and Headquarters made calls to check their needs and wellbeing.

- Regardless of whether they were affected by the disaster, all TEV grantees received their scholarship payments a week early.
- An additional one-month scholarship payment was made to 2573 grantees who were in the disaster region.
- In the scholarship interviews conducted a few months before the disaster, a one-time scholarship payment was made to 1,318 students whose student status, success, and financial need were identified in the interviews, but who could not be granted a scholarship due to quota limitations and whose school or family was in the disaster region.

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

TEV tracks the success of its grantees every year. Scholarships of students, who are determined to be successful, continue until they graduate from their education institution.

- To support students affected by the disaster, a new scholarship application call was announced in the interim period and 94 thousand applications were received within a week. Following the document and declaration checks, 1,360 university students who were identified as the most severely affected were provided with scholarship support for 4 months between March and June. An additional TL 500 meal allowance was added to the TL 1,325 education scholarship with the support of Yemeksepeti and Multinet. Followed by a Board of Directors decision taken in the summer, it has been decided
- that these students affected by the disaster will continue as TEV Education Higher Education Grantees in 2023-24.
- Nearly a thousand Foundation grantees affected by the disaster were given computers due to the transition to distance education.
- TEV Board of Directors has decided to continue the scholarships of all grantees for the year 2023-24, regardless of their achievement status, as it is recognized that more than 80% of the grantees were directly and indirectly affected by the disaster.
- The civil initiative 'Together We Will Heal' provides psychosocial support services to students affected by the disaster.
- A protocol was signed between the General Directorate of Secondary Education and the General Directorate of Basic Education of the Ministry of National Education and TEV to provide scholarships to K-12 students who were identified to be affected by the disaster.

TEV tracks the success of its grantees every year. Scholarships of students, who are determined to be successful, continue until they graduate from their education institution. Scholarship of the students, that ended due to their failure, will continue as of the following year if the said students improve their success status.

Success Awards

In addition to providing scholarships, TEV offers "Award Scholarships" to grantees who meet the success conditions specified in the Domestic Scholarship and Award Regulation, to promote success. Of the grantees who maintained their success status at the end of the 2022-2023 academic year despite the impacts of COVID-19, 1,686 were granted awards as per the regulation. The number of achievement awards granted by TEV has reached 39,905.

Some scholarships are partially or fully refundable. Conditions are stated in the announcement of each scholarship program.

Information regarding international scholarships is published on the Turkish Education Foundation website in October and November every year.

ALUMNI AND GRANTEE PROJECTS

As part of alumni and grantee projects, a total of 50 events and trainings were organized with the participation of more than 5,000 grantees.

The Alumni and Grantee Projects Unit was established in 2017 to strengthen ties between the Turkish Education Foundation and its graduates, to increase solidarity, and to improve communication between them. The main purpose of the unit is to update the alumni information system and to ensure that alumni are informed about each other and the events organized by TEV. In this way, effective, efficient, and sustainable communication can be established with the alumni.

Information Update

Information on our alumni, whose lives we touched and whose stories we were a part of during their education, continued to be updated in 2023. Since 2017, TEV Branches and Education Unit have updated the information of about 58,442 grantees.

ALUMNI AND GRANTEE PROJECTS

TEV-We Will Heal Together Psycho-Social Support Project

On February 6, 2023, the Foundation launched the TEV - "We Will Heal Together" project, an initiative that seeks to understand the impact of the earthquake on grantees affected by the disaster, to support them, and to help them continue their university education. The main objective of the project is to thoroughly assess and identify the trauma, stress, and psychological difficulties caused by the earthquake. In this regard, one of the primary objectives is to contribute to the well-being of grantees and enable them to continue their university education. The project also aims to increase TEV's ability to effectively respond to crises.

The work carried out within the scope of this special initiative covers several areas. Firstly, a software program was designed specifically for TEV to ensure that the project is effectively managed and that solutions are customized for the needs of the grantees. In addition, a call center, which was created to respond to student calls instantly, is supported by experts. This ensures quick and effective solutions to the challenges faced by grantees. 63 students received support from this program in 2023. In addition, online meetings were organized to contribute to the students' wellbeing, and events were organized with the participation of successful psychiatrists, experts, and artists.

TEV Grantees Meeting

On May 3, 2023, a grantee meeting sponsored by Yapı Kredi Bank gathered TEV's successful alumni as well as prominent figures from the business and art community. Nearly 500 grantees participated in this meeting, and alumni from all over Türkiye and around the world had the opportunity to join the meeting online via live broadcast.

TEV Mentorink

In addition to the scholarships it provides to its grantees, TEV also offers a wide range of support to help them transition from their educational lives to the professional world as fully prepared individuals. Being a platform that provides knowledge and experience based on mutual development by ensuring the most appropriate match between alumni and scholars, TEV Mentorink offers its alumni and grantees an online mentoring platform specific to TEV Education-Friendly institutions.

In 2023, EMCC Türkiye Social Responsibility Group Leader Banu Aykın Köylüer organized training for mentees and mentors, and a series of online events to promote the program.

Almost 500 members of TEV family attended these events.

TRAINING-EVENTS

TEV-Turkcell Grantees Development Program

As part of the Turkcell Academy-Turkish Education Foundation partnership, the TEV-Turkcell Scholar Development Program aims to effectively support grantees supported by TEV on the journey toward their careers and professions.

This specialized training program has an online, accredited structure that includes online classroom training, video content, examinations, e-learning modules, and webinars. The program was designed based on the needs of the grantees and the efficiency analysis studies.

Within the scope of the program, over 1,000 undergraduate students benefited from 9 months of training and development opportunities. This process has been specifically planned to provide scholars with sectorspecific skills, shape their careers, and develop their areas of expertise.

More than 500 participants participated in "Tea Talk," "Future of Work," and "Design Thinking" training held in three separate sessions as part of the TEV and McKinsey cooperation. Training sessions proceeded with the interactive workshops.

English Course

English course support is one of the non-scholarship activities offered to TEV grantees. To identify the grantees who will benefit from the support, a survey was sent to understand the need, success, and motivation for having online language education. Nearly 2,000 grantees participated in the survey.

The project was launched to contribute to the development of individuals by providing discounts at certain rates in all languages to TEV alumni, TEV employees, and their relatives.

Branch Offices signed language agreement protocols with numerous institutions during the year. Cooperations were made with schools such as AmericanLife, Private Trabzon Moda Language Academy, YDS Academy Private Foreign Language Education, Wimbledon Language Academy, and AmericanLife Language School, and face-to-face and online training sessions were held in numerous provinces of Türkiye. Training events will continue also in 2023.

"Women's Health Seminars" with Yasemin Yakut

A session on the topic of the current perspective on women's health was held in the Young Women's Health Seminar Program with Yasemin Yakut, MD.

In cooperation with the mobile education platform, Kunduz, particularly the 4th year vocational high school students were provided with question and solution support through the Kunduz application. About 400 grantees studying at vocational high schools benefited from the free education support.

Istanbul Metropolitan **Municipality-Regional Employment** Offices

In cooperation with TEV-Regional Employment Offices, TEV grantees were provided with part-time job opportunities and internship support. In 2023, more than 158 TEV grantees completed internships at Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality and its subsidiaries.

UnoMoi Clothes Support Project

As part of the project carried out with UnoMoi, TEV grantees were able to wear UnoMoi's designs from worldfamous brands at their graduations, birthday parties, important events, and, most importantly, internship/ job interviews at no cost. 145 students benefited from the program.

TEV International Alumni Meeting

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On December 22, 2023, TEV Hope Meetings were held at Villa Bosphorus in Istanbul, bringing international alumni together.

TEV x BCG 360° Consulting Program

TEV's high-merit grantees benefited from this program in the 2022-2023 academic year. The grantees who will participate in the program will have the opportunity to;

- One-to-one meetings with BCG employees of different levels,
- Many training sessions such as case solution studies, interview and resume preparation techniques and problem solving,
- Taking part in the 6-month BCG mentorship program,
- The students had the opportunity to intern at BCG Türkiye at the end of the program.

Internship, Career Counseling, and **Career Opportunities**

TEV provides internship and job opportunities for grantees via its alumni and partner organizations. To date, internship and career support has been provided in cooperation with nearly 1,100 organizations.

TEV Alumni Funding

Individual and institutional funds were established with the contributions of alumni grantees, and nearly TL 5.5 million was donated in 2023. In addition, thanks to Turkcell, 60 computers were provided to students who were affected by the disaster. In 5 years, more than TL 20 million was donated in total.

OUR DORMITORIES

In 2023, TEV has accelerated its efforts to expand the capacity of the modern, safe, and comfortable accommodation it offers to young people.

We Provide Safe and Comfortable Accommodation for Our Students The students who stay in TEV dormitories benefit from the food and housing aid provided by the Ministry of Youth and Sports to students staying in higher education dormitories belonging to tax-exempt foundations and public benefit associations.

In 2023, TEV has accelerated its efforts to expand the capacity of the modern, safe, and comfortable accommodation it offers to young people. In this regard, the Foundation signed protocols for the construction of two new higher education girls' dormitories in Balçova, Izmir, with a capacity of 154, and in Yenimahalle, Ankara, with a capacity of 352. Dormitory constructions are ongoing. Private Turkish Education Foundation Sedef Ölçer Higher Education Girls Dormitory (Ankara)

The TEV Sedef Ölçer Private Higher Education Girls Dormitory was opened at service of female students in December 2015. It is centrally located on the main transportation lines. The dormitory has a capacity of 189 students. It renders accommodation service to paid and scholarship female students. The dormitory has 7 five-person, 35 four-person, and 7 two-person rooms. Each room has a bathroom and WC, a personal desk, a bookshelf, a closet and a shoe cabinet. Offering female students a modern living space, the dormitory has a cafeteria, drawing atelier, Internet service, computer room, prayer room, luggage room, infirmary, study room, TV and free-time space, gym area and project drawing room, table-tennis table, and a refrigerator, iron and ironing table on each floor. Students are provided with free breakfast, as well as optional dinner for a fee. Professional administrative staff and security team hold offices in dormitories.

Furthermore, common areas and outer spaces have a camera security system. Personal accident insurance is provided for each student who stay in the dormitory. Various trainings and courses are organized for the personal and social development of students.

Private Turkish Education Foundation Cumhuriyet Higher Education Girls Dormitory (İzmir)

Private TEV Cumhurivet Higher Education Women's Dormitory was brought into the use of students in 2011. It is within walking distance of general transportation lines, Dokuz Eylül University Faculty of Medical-Nursing-Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation, Dokuz Eylül University Health Vocational School and İzmir University of Economics. It is also close to İzmir University of Democracy and is accessible to Eqe University by metro. Its 373-student capacity serves both grantees and paid students. The dormitory has 124 three-person rooms and 1 room for the disabled. Each room features a closet, desk, bathroom, toilette, central heating and cooling, and Wi-Fi. Offering female students a modern living space, the dormitory has a cafeteria, a computer room, study rooms, a drawing room, TV and free-time spaces, a garden, a visitor's room, an infirmary, a prayer room, a library, a laundry room, a food-beverage dispenser,

and a table-tennis table. It has a management staff and a professional security team serving 24 hours a day, as well as a camera security system. Personal accident insurance is also provided for each student. Seminars and training are organized for the personal and social development of students who stay in the dormitory. Students can also make use of the nearby sports complex. The dormitory building, which offers a modern living space, features three-person rooms with forest and sea views. The dormitory is available to both grantees and all students seeking a safe family environment for a fee.

Private Turkish Education Foundation Higher Education Girls Dormitory (Trabzon)

The dormitory, which is 1.5 km away from Karadeniz Technical University, was opened in 2012 with a bed capacity of 252 students. The students who stay at the dormitory in the 2022-2023 academic year have predominantly come from Istanbul, Ankara, Kocaeli, and Samsun. The total number of cities from which the dormitory students have come is 45. In addition, 1 student is from Djibouti, a country in East Africa. In this academic year, the number of female students is 149, 46 of whom are grantees. The dormitory features 63 fourperson rooms including one for the disabled. Each room has desk, closet, coat check, dresser, bathroom and toilette. It is aimed to meet various needs of students and offer a life space to them. The dormitory has a cafeteria, dining hall, canteen, sports room, laundry, multi-purpose meeting room, lobby, prayer room, and many other rooms such as TV, study, computer, drawing, and dental care room. Rooms have wired Internet access while common areas have Wi-Fi Internet access. Other services such as a central heating system and technical services are also provided. Common areas and





outer spaces of the dormitory are monitored with camera recording systems. Professional administrative staff and security team hold office there. The dormitory offers breakfast, dinner, university shuttle service, and personal accident insurance to each student free of charge.

Each student staying at the dormitory is provided with breakfast and free personal accident insurance. The dormitory also offers fast food, dinner, and a shuttle service from and to the university at certain times of the day at an affordable price.

Students are also backed up in terms of social development. In this regard, training sessions about communal life culture, professional goal setting, English, leadership, and development of personal and social skills are given to them. In addition, TEV prioritizes gathering together on national and religious holidays, commemoration days, New Year's Eve, etc. to emphasize the meaning and importance of the day and to be together with students.

TEVİTÖL

TEVITÖL's mission is to identify the unique characteristics and talents of each student and to foster these talents to the highest level.

At TEVİTÖL (TEV İnanç Türkeş Private High School) which gives education to the students with special abilities, curriculum of Anatolian High Schools as well as the special ability development programs in different fields of art and science are applied. Contributing to versatile development of students, TEVİTÖL is the only institution that provides privileged education needed by the students with special abilities, as a co-ed boarding school today.

In 1990, the founder of STFA, the late Sezai Türkes established a foundation to open a school to honor the memory of his deceased wife, İnanç Türkeş, and to ensure the education of the bright children with limited financial means. In line with this purpose, in 1993, the Foundation opened Private İnanç High School which then would be a boarding school for 300 students. TEV took over İnanc High School in 2001. The school was renamed The Turkish Education Foundation Inanc Türkeş Private High School (TEVITÖL). The boarding school, TEVITÖL gave its first graduates in 2000.

TEVİTÖL's campus is located in Gebze Muallimköv, on approximately 414 decares of land, 30,000 m² of which is closed area. In addition to five different education buildings, the school campus has TEV Nevin Mehmet Bilginer Culture and Art Center, a meeting and performance hall with a 500-person capacity in this center, Güher and Süher Pekinel music classrooms, eight separate student dormitories, infirmary, cafeteria, science laboratories, visual arts workshops, robotics workshops, a half-Olympic swimming pool, outdoor and indoor sports fields and teacher lodgings, and a wide range of opportunities for sports, science and art.

With 280 students from 42 provinces, TEVİTÖL has 904 alumni as of 2023. About 30% of the TEVİTÖL alumni studied or currently study at prominent universities such as Jacobs, Drexel, Bocconi, Delft, Columbia, Duke, Harvard, MIT, Stanford, Brown, and Yale. The teaching staff at the school consists of 46 full-time and 10 part-time teachers.

Educational Mentality in TEVİTÖL

The "Private Anatolian High School" program is officially implemented at the school. Holistic development of the bright students is taken into account with the T21C program, which started to be implemented as of 2019 and focuses on research and questioning along with the skills of the 21st century, and extracurricular cultural and social activities. Enriching content of the education programs according to the abilities of its students, TEVİTÖL formed its academic staff in a way that 1 teacher will be assigned to 6 students. Two-thirds of the students turn towards the field of science and natural sciences, while the others are classified to study in the fields of economics, law, and social sciences.

Education is performed with a class size of 20 people in special learning spaces arranged according to needs of the students. German is the second language taught. The students with an advanced level of German are supported with extracurricular certificate courses.

TOEFL ITP and TOEFL IBT exams are applied to track English level and level targets of the students. English program was designed by the school teachers based on T21C philosophy, considering the interests and skills of the students.

Güher & Süher Pekinel Music Department

The department was established in the 2006-2007 academic year with the support of Güher & Süher Pekinel pianist sisters, upon the profound requests of TEVİTÖL students and the management. The Music Department aims to enhance the quality of TEVİTÖL as an exemplary school in this field by taking the music course, which is offered as an elective course in many schools but does not bring any results due to insufficient infrastructure, to the highest level possible.



TEVİTÖL

The obligation to conduct research and write essays, which is part of the TEVITÖL education system, aims to help students develop their research, creativity, and presentation skills.

Students at Güher & Süher Pekinel Music Department absorb the inspiring and relaxing effect of music to excel at an instrument, with disciplined efforts and the support of their teachers, who are lecturers and orchestra artists in conservatories. Students are selected for the department after the musical perception exam and are included in the program that contains general music education, solfege, and music history courses. Although TEVITÖL is not a music school, the training students receive in the music department is equivalent to the first level of a part-time conservatory.

Bright students are provided with the most appropriate environment and are enabled to use their capacities at the highest level through fitting methods and educational programs.

Clubs & Activities

Obligation to do research and write articles, which is a part of the education system, aims to improve students' skills in research, creativity and presentation. Other than academic education, students exhibit their high potential by engaging in various activities that develop themselves during the activities. Since these events and clubs are organized and run by students, they also improve the organizational skills and sense of responsibility of young people.

The school has more than 60 active student clubs. Each student participates in at least two clubs, one of which is community service, every year from Prep Class to Grade 11, and continues their extracurricular activities. In particular, clubs such as IMC (İnanç Mechatronics Club), MUN (Model United Nations), Drama, Entrepreneurship, VEX robotics, drone, web design, sports clubs, debate, mathematics, and philosophy have achieved great success in the national and international scene.

The benefactors, who are the real reason behind the value that TEV generates for society, are provided with moral support through good and bad times to ensure their safety and security.

BENEFACTOR RELATIONS DEPARTMENT

TEV benefactors make up the Foundation's significant value sources with their will and grant donations. One of the most important responsibilities of the foundation is to meet the moral obligations regarding the needs and wishes of its valuable benefactors. With this approach, we always meet the needs of our benefactors, who are the real custodians of the value TEV generates for society, to the extent possible, and provide them with moral support in both good and bad times to make them feel safe and secure.

During 2023, as part of the moral services we provide to our will and grant benefactors, we contacted them regularly by phone, asking about their needs and wishes, and if they requested help, we regularly followed up and fulfill their needs within the bounds of the Foundation's possibility. Besides, we organized celebrations on their special days, making sure our benefactors did not feel alone.

When our benefactors faced health problems, we made doctor/hospital appointments and accompanied them to hospitals, paying attention to hygiene rules throughout the examination/ treatment processes carried out on the same day. When they needed to go to the hospital for treatment and examinations, our foundation vehicles or an ambulance took them to the hospital, and we gave them as much moral support as we could.

Throughout 2023, within the service contracts drawn up every year, our will and grant benefactors benefited from the "Medical Counseling, Emergency Aid, Ambulance, and Doctor Service" sections for use in emergency health needs, approximately 71 times at different periods free of charge. An ambulance was directed to the homes of benefactors who had requested an ambulance in case of need.

Within the scope of service contracts made for TEV benefactors, contracts were made with health institutions, hospitals and nursing homes for benefactors who do not have any health insurance. and Elderly Care Center, Private Asude Life and Health Centers, Suadiye Nursing Home Elderly Care Center, Hatice Satoğlu Nursing Home, Kadıköy Health Education Center Foundation (KASEV), Nezih Nursing Home, Kızılay Care Zeynep M. Nedim Oyvar Nursing Home.

We cooperate with the nursing homes and suggest them to our benefactors who want to live in a more social environment, and to protect or increase their quality of life, or who want to stay at the nursing home temporarily or permanently to receive regular care. They can accept such locations the cost of which will be covered by themselves. We visited these institutions together with the requesting benefactors. If they are deemed appropriate, moral support is provided to them and the procedures of the institutions they chose were fulfilled. We enabled the relevant benefactors to settle into the nursing home they demanded.

• Healthy Living and VeNatura **Scholarship Fund**

Healthy Living and VeNatura Scholarship Fund was established by Nurçin and Okan Çağlar, the founders of We Live Healthy community, in cooperation with Vefa İlaç within the social responsibility movement.

• With the scholarship fund created, it continues to grow rapidly by providing scholarship support to 50 undergraduate students maioring in Medicine, Nutrition and Dietetics, and Pharmacy in 2019/2020, 75 in 2020/2021, 150 in 2021/2022, and 150 in 2022/2023. With a second protocol, Nurcin and Okan Çağlar established the Healthy Living Scholarship Fund in 2021. The earthquake disaster that hit Türkiye on February 6 affected 1 out of every 5 students in elementary education, leaving hundreds of thousands of students at risk of guitting their education. TEV launched the "Continue Education" campaign with FOX so that the education, dreams, and stories of our students affected by the disaster would not be interrupted.

World diving record holder national athlete Şahika Ercümen set a world record by diving to 106 meters in Yayladağı, Hatay to support 100 female students on the 100th anniversary of our Republic.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

METU Scholarship Fund

METU Scholarship Fund was established in 2009 by the Foundation's volunteer Arif Aygündüz and has been TEV's largest fund and the most net value-added project for the last 8 years. In 14 years, a total of 3,615 scholarship opportunities have been created and 585 Middle East Technical University (METU) students have been granted scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year. Since 2014, 108 of the 392 graduates have supported young people as benefactors, demonstrating that they are the guarantors of the fund's future. 33.5% of regular monthly benefactors in 34 countries around the world have supported the Fund for a period of 10 years or more.

METU Scholarship Fund also provides mentor support from its alumni and coaching support from internationally certified coaches.

In 2023, 267 grantees benefited from these supports. Each semester, a four-day alumni- grantee meeting is organized at the Ankara campus, and the constructive relationships established at these events contribute to grantees finding internships and jobs.

TEV-Corona Heroes Memorial Scholarship Fund

With the "Corona Heroes Memorial Scholarship Fund" created in 2020, the children of healthcare workers who lost their lives in the fight against coronavirus, and the children of individuals who died from the virus during the corona period throughout their education life, and those who suffered financial damage due to the pandemic were supported. Backed up by our corporate and individual benefactors, scholarship support continues to be provided at primary, high school, undergraduate, and postgraduate and doctorate levels.

Following the earthquake that affected Kahramanmaraş and nearby provinces, the "Don't Give up on Education 2023 Scholarship Fund" was established to support our university students affected by the disaster and to provide scholarship support throughout their education.

Transportation Assistance Scholarship Fund

In addition to the education scholarship given to TEV scholars, transportation scholarship support continues to be provided so they can meet their transportation needs.

Stationery/Book Assistance Scholarship Fund

In addition to the education scholarship given to TEV scholars, stationery/book scholarship support continues to be provided so that they can meet their stationery/book needs.

Social Activity Scholarship Fund

In addition to the educational scholarship given to TEV scholars, social activity scholarship support continues to be provided for them to carry out their social activities.

TEV-Natural Disaster Relief Fund of Students

SPORTS ACTIVITIES

Adım Adım İyilik Peşinde Koş Platformu (Run for Good Step by Step Platform)

Adım Adım İyilik Peşinde Koş Platform is an organization that brings NGOs and individual & institutional volunteers together. This year, the Turkish Education Foundation raised TL 7,103,064 by attending 9 sports activities together with Adım Adım and reaching 12,772 benefactors with 1,875 volunteer sportspeople.

Runtalya Marathon

With the 2023 Antalya Marathon, the Foundation's 181 volunteer athletes collected TL 1,843,933 in donations through this project, which aims to reach out to students affected by disasters with the motto "Don't Give Up On School."



Maratonİzmir

With the virtual run organized in Izmir as part of the "Don't Give Up On School" project, the Foundation's 17 volunteer athletes donated TL 147,912 and provided scholarship support to students affected by the disaster.

The 45th Istanbul Marathon

A total of 76 organizations ran for TEV in the 2023 Istanbul Marathon. 6,537 people made donations to 1,175 runners who started campaigns for the Foundation, reaching a donation of TL 3,647,465 and providing 1-year scholarship support to 162 students. TEV became the 3rd highest fund-raiser among the NGOs participating in the Istanbul Marathon.

OTHER EVENTS

We participated in these marathons with volunteer athletes in the Adım Adım İyilik Peşinde Koş Platform, respectively: İznik Ultra Marathon, Istanbul Half Marathon, Runkara Half Marathon, Eker I Run Bursa Run and Büyükada Half Marathon.

Apart from Adım Adım, volunteer athletes participated in Adana January 5th Liberation Half Marathon, Rome Marathon, Athens Half Marathon, Saint-Joseph High School, Belgrade Run, Under Armour Bodrum Half Marathon and Gökova Half Marathon.

Collaboration with the Turkish Rowing Federation

During the Turkish Sea Rowing Championships held in Izmir between October 8-10, TL 51,375 was donated by 15 volunteer athletes of the Foundation through a campaign launched by the Turkish Rowing Federation.

TEV WREATHES

TEV Wreathes make up a significant way of fundraising started in 1972.

Vehbi Koç talked about this subject in 1971 as follows:

".... As a result of studies and research we've done to provide scholarships to more young people, we've understood that we can provide 250-300 young people with additional scholarships through the flower and wreath money paid for weddings, engagements, celebrations, openings, and funerals in Istanbul."

Main source of these words was an ongoing practice in Sweden.

On a business trip to Sweden in 1968, Vehbi Koc saw several large and beautiful buildings outside Stockholm and asked what they were. He learned that they are special housing for alone and low-income elders. Wreath donations were used to construct and maintain these housings. Vehbi Koç rose interest and he kept examining the subject.

In 1917, 91 wreaths were sent to the funeral of the famous Swedish architecture Ludwig Heidi who died at the age of 91. His daughter Alma Heidi thought that the money spent on wreaths could be directed to a social aid. Therefore, she established a foundation in 1921: the Flower Foundation. In funerals, flowers were replaced by a metal wreath symbolizing the wreath donation. In the course of time, the custom of donating to the Flower Foundation became common.

He aspired to direct the funeral wreaths, which constitute 5% of flower consumption, to the wreath fund to be established at TEV.

The use of donations instead of wreaths began with the death announcement for the funeral of Vehbi Koç's sister, Hüsniye Aktar which was published on January 1, 1972. This first wreath donation corresponded to TL 20,000. A total wreath donations of TL 325,000 were raised in that year.



DONATION ADMISSION

In 2023, the field operation processes started to be monitored with the tablet application and an innovative step in digitalization was taken. The follow-up processes of funeral and happy day ceremonies were carried out entirely on tablets, and wreath images, receipt entries and information entries of relatives of the deceased were transferred to the digital platform.

The workload of the call center and operations team was reduced by eliminating communication via e-mail, WhatsApp, SMS, and telephone.

of work flows and processes was increased by eliminating manual processes with the control of receipts received from the field and visual delivery of wreaths.





On the office side, the efficiency



Manual practices related to collection processes (collection at the address, in-person delivery of the collection card to the benefactors) have been eliminated, allowing for tablet-based collection and instant communication with the benefactors via e-mail.

As of September 1, 2023, the cash collection process was eliminated and the process of receiving cash donations at the address was terminated.

In 2023, TEV continued its communication activities both in traditional and digital media in order to increase its recognition and visibility among audiences.

While the total donations collected by the "Municipalities Supporting Education" projects in 2023 amounted to TL 4,043,231, the donations collected in the 10 different "Municipalities Supporting Education" projects implemented so far reached TL 4,478,939.

LEGAL

Legal Counsel's Office endeavors to provide legal counsel and opinions to the units and branches of the Foundation as necessary, ensuring compliance with legal regulations in all areas of the Foundation's activities.

Legal Counsel's Office: It is responsible for ensuring the legal background of all transactions of the Turkish Education Foundation to ensure that all activities it performs to reach the goals described in the authenticated contract of the Foundation, comply with the existing laws and the in-house legislation, and for bringing solutions to legal disputes within the framework of the applicable laws. In this regard, it represents the Foundation in all judicial authorities, arbitrators, execution offices and notaries, as well as in mediation negotiations.

The Legal Counsel's Office prioritizes preventive legal advice and measures over defensive legal action and to create an environment to sustain this principle within the entire Foundation including all departments and branch offices, as well as ensuring the legal compliance of the activities. In this sense, necessary opinions and reports on legal measures are presented without filing a lawsuit, and it is aimed to eliminate any potential problems against the Foundation before they arise. Within the scope of the said activities, the case and execution files brought in favor and against the Foundation across the country in 2023 were tracked by the Legal Counsel's Office. The total number of cases which were brought in favor and against our Foundation in 2023 and were handed on and followed up from previous years is 727. As of 2023, 211 of these cases were concluded. 193 of them were in our favor and 18 of them against us.

71 of the settled cases are related to the opening of the will and the delivery of the estate. In consequence of these cases, as of 2023, 30 real estate amounting to TL 108,248,600 were registered in the name of the Foundation, and cash assets corresponding to TL 16,934,850.05 were transferred to the Foundation account.

Moreover, copyright permits and contracts of the benefactors and testators, who are copyright holders, were signed. The copyrights and the rights protected by the professional associations were followed up and the relevant revenues were transferred to the Foundation. Besides, all law and legislation changes that came into force in 2019 were closely followed and the works with other units of the Foundation continued to make necessary arrangements, changes and transactions within the entire foundation, especially within the framework of the provisions of the "Law on the Protection of Personal Data."

Within the mediation and settlement system introduced with the Law amendment made in 2018, the mediation process is also carried out for the disputes to which the Foundation is a party.

Additionally, rental readjustment lawsuits have been initiated in order to adapt the rentals to the current date's market rates, as these fees constitute a significant portion of the Foundation's income. Necessary measures have been taken in order to protect the financial interests of the Foundation via enacting the lessor's rights extended under the Code of Obligations, which resulted in peaceful settlements with a significant portion of the lessees without initiating a time and resource consuming litigation procedure. In this context, the necessary legal process were initiated in order to ensure the collection of unpaid rents, enforcement proceedings were made against the indebted tenants who refused to pay the rent, and the collection of rental income and the eviction of the problematic tenants were ensured. Of 648 execution files which were initiated in 2023 or date back to previous years, enforcement of 84 files were ensured and a total of TL 7,839,388.59 was collected.

Contracts drawn up regarding all kinds of projects and services to which the Foundation is a party are first checked by the Legal Counsel's Office to prevent possible problems in the future, and approved by us in a controlled way. Special contracts were prepared by the Counsel's Office. The projects and contracts to which the Foundation is a party were concluded without dispute. On the other hand, interviews were made with the candidates, who want to make a will to the Foundation through testamentary disposition or donate by way of inter vivos transfer, based on their demands. Detailed legal information about the legal definition and results of the savings they want to make was provided. Legal support was granted to the benefactors, who wanted to make a will, in order to ensure that their wills are made in accordance with their wishes. Donation protocols were prepared in line with the aims and wishes of the benefactors who wanted to make donations. As a result of these meetings, a total of 65 people made a will and 6 people made donations in 2023.



In addition, legal processes for the appointment of a guardian and/or financial advisor to ensure the legal protection of those who lost their legal capacity or became unable to protect their rights and interests, by providing the necessary assistance and support to solve the legal problems that benefactors and testators face in their daily lives were initiated and followed up.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Based on the idea of positioning human resources to generate and utilize knowledge, TEV works tirelessly to support successful students with limited financial means who aspire to continue their education.

Human Resources that Is Open to Change and Guiding Development

Core vision of the Turkish Education Foundation is primarily to enable human resources to produce and use knowledge. Within this framework, Human Resources Unit was established in 2010. TEV provides service to both its benefactors and grantees with its 256 employees at the Head Office, 13 Branches, 3 Girls' Dormitories and TEVİTÖL. Human Resources aims to promote the setting of the policies that support the Foundation's values, mission, and vision, and to optimize human resources management in line with the Foundation's goals.

Based on the idea of positioning human resources to generate and utilize knowledge, TEV works tirelessly to support successful students with limited financial means who aspire to continue their education and to contribute to their education life by standing behind the students through various scholarships, while promoting the education system by building schools, dormitories, education centers, and libraries.

The Foundation aims to be an institution that regards employee satisfaction, manages processes with a focus on continuous improvement and mutual open communication, strives to support its employees in developing their skills and potential, cares about the needs and expectations of employees and creates a fair working environment for them.

Activities went on in 2023 to make the organizational structure and business models more plain, agile and efficient.

Recruitment

In 2023, the Turkish Education Foundation, with its 13 Branches, 3 Girls' Dormitories, Head Office, and TEV İnanç Türkeş Private High School, employed an average of 256 employees.

In 2023, a total of 13 definite and 37 indefinite new employees joined the Foundation at TEV Headquarters, branches, and dormitories, 5 under the "First Opportunity Program" and 8 with fixed-term employment contracts. 11 of these employees quit their positions at the end of their fixed-term employment contracts, 10 due to retirement and 22 for various reasons.

In 2023, 48% of the employees hired were women, while 52% were men. As of the end of 2023, 56% of the management team were women, while 44% were men.

Evaluation processes of all candidates who apply for job advertisements are performed in an objective and effective manner. Although the recruitment process may vary by position, the stages of personality inventory, case study, proficiency exam, and reference check are always applied. To positively strengthen the recruitment experience and its effect on employee loyalty during the adaptation process, several practices are carried out on the first day: giving out a TEV Welcome kit, making an internal welcome announcement across the foundation and organizing acquaintance meetings. A general orientation program is also organized for employees who have just joined the TEV Family, in which all units explain their internal workings and practices, in order to get to know the institution better and speed up the adaptation process to the institution.

We Bolster up New Graduate Recruitment

As part of the First Opportunity Project launched by Esas Sosyal to help new graduates have their first work experience, employment of young people in 5 positions was supported and their recruitment processes were completed in 2023. Thus, thanks to the First Opportunity Program, both the employment of new graduates and the business processes of the units were backed up.

Employee Satisfaction Survey

As part of human resources development and improvement activities, the second Employee Satisfaction Survey, which was conducted for the first time in the history of the Foundation in 2022, was carried out again in December 2023, through the BAREM Consultancy firm. An assessment survey was conducted to measure the satisfaction and loyalty levels of employees, evaluating areas such as corporate culture and values, management practices, and communication environment. This contributed to identifying the strengths and areas for improvement in TEV's corporate policies and practices, as well as creating roadmaps for addressing areas requiring more improvement.

Employee Satisfaction Workshops, Values Workshop

A total of 14 workshops were conducted, 6 of which were online and 8 were face-to-face, where the results of the 2022 Employee Satisfaction Survey were evaluated together with employees across the Foundation. Approximately 42 hours were spent on these workshops, and joint roadmaps were drawn up with the employees. Within these workshops, for the first time in the history of the Foundation, a value measurement application was implemented, and common corporate values were determined with the participation of all employees.

Employee Performance Reviews and Exit Interviews

To monitor the Foundation's organizational development, maintain its "well-being" and take the necessary actions within the appropriate time frame when needed, the initial six-month employee evaluation interviews, which started in 2022, also continued in 2023. During approximately 15 hours of meetings, experience sharing sessions were conducted with the employees, resulting in outputs that nourish the corporate culture of the Foundation.

In exit interviews systematically conducted since 2021, approximately 13 hours of meetings were held throughout the year 2023. Human Resources has completed the necessary reporting for identifying TEV's areas for improvement through exit interviews supported by exit surveys and has transformed action plans into various implementations throughout the year.

Training

Within the framework of the executive training event, a 2-day "Branch Managers Development Program" was organized in May, specifically designed for Branch Presidents, focusing on alignment, establishing a management approach that speaks the common language, working together, and increasing performance and productivity.

Launched at the end of 2022, the Leader Development Program continued in 2023, and TEV's executive staff received a total of 24 hours of leadership development training per person, with follow-up sessions of approximately 28 hours each, every 6 months throughout the program.

Employees have been provided with opportunities to participate in various external training programs to enable them to keep up with current technical practices according to the needs of their units and contribute to their professional development.



Internal Communication and Motivation

In 2023, in moderation of the Human Resources unit, Common Ground meetings were held in the last week of every month, and a process, in which the information of all Foundation employees' was synchronized and they were aware of the Foundation's agenda, was implemented.

The new TEV portal, which was launched during the year, continues to share current legislation and information with all employees through the new portal.

Efforts to document all business processes and accelerate digitalization have also been intensified throughout the year.

In 2023, motivational activity budgets were established for all TEV employees, and all employees across the Foundation were supported to participate in various activities planned with their managers.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES

The Information Technology Unit continues its efforts by adding various innovations to the system to implement pioneering practices, increase efficiency, digitize labor-intensive tasks, and further elevate the success graph.

These locations include the TEV Head Office, the Anatolian Side Benefactor Relations Department, 13 branch offices, the Turkish Education Foundation İnanç Türkeş Private High School (TEVİTÖL), women's dormitories in İzmir, Trabzon and Ankara, and the Garring schools in Istanbul, Sakarya and Kırşehir. In addition, it occasionally provides support to the many schools built by TEV and transferred to the Ministry of National Education.

The unit is responsible for the online connections (remote area network), Internet connections, security systems, and entire e-mail traffic of TEV branches. It also provides continuous support for more than 50 servers and more than 400 computers/consumables, switchboards, call centers, websites, operating software, and all kinds of electronic products in use.

In 2023, it included many innovations in the system to implement pioneering practices that will increase our efficiency, digitize labor-intensive work, and raise our success rate even higher.

Activities in 2023

System Developments

· Project and process management phases were moved to the Jira application by Atlassian, the most widely used tool in the world. In this way, it has been possible to follow the workflow processes and respond to the requests of users, problems, and errors with agile methodologies. Time analysis studies were carried out on unitbased spent times and situations, and efficient business and process management was ensured. • A hybrid work tracking system was set up using Power Apps technologies, and the entire foundation was able to monitor the work locations of employees. • By integrating the card access system with the hybrid working application, all working modes, including the office environment,

- were reported.
- To contribute to corporate identity applications, central e-mail signature integration was implemented.

- As part of the efforts to provide computer support for grantees affected by the disaster, a new screen was developed on AX to track all computers donated to the foundation after they were received. By printing barcodes on the PCs and registering them in the system, all applications that students may need were controlled. Actions have been taken and improvements have been made for the functions that have problems. Screen improvements were made to monitor delivery processes; 1,000 computers were controlled within 2 months, deficiencies were resolved and they were made available for the use of students.
- The new portal infrastructure was created and put into operation.
- Wireless network infrastructure was renewed in the Head Office offices. All APs were renewed and made Wi-Fi 6 supported. Wireless internet speed has been increased by about 4 times.
- An announcement was added to the switchboard structure within the scope of Personal Data Protection Law compliance studies.
- New reports and applications were added to the system for more optimized use of call center processes.
- The TEV websites were improved and upgraded, and an online membership system was introduced.
- The website of TEVİTÖL has been renewed.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES

Due to the earthquake disaster, the IT equipment and camera system were installed in the administration office and teachers' room of the container school built in cooperation with Eczacibasi in Adiyaman.

- Microsites were established for earthquake relief campaigns, contributing to fund raising.
- The sound and announcement system at Ümraniye TEV Zahide Zehra Garring Secondary School was renewed and IT equipment was installed for management.
- Microsoft System Center Operations Manager system has been installed and integrated into the infrastructure, enabling the monitoring of critical server services and generating alarms in case of potential issues. This allows for early action to be taken in case of any potential issues.
- Due to the earthquake disaster, the IT equipment and camera system were installed in the administration office and teachers' room of the container school built in cooperation with Eczacıbaşı in Adıyaman.

Security Activities

- a. With the installation and integration of Microsoft SCCM: controlled, automatic distribution of Windows operating system security updates to computers and the ability to install them on computers remotely from central screens were ensured.
- b. As part of the Personal Data Protection Law compliance efforts, a data classification and labeling system has been implemented; files containing data have been tagged, and users have been informed about this matter.
- c. To elevate information security to a higher level, starting with the branches, devices that do

- not contain security software and that pose information security risks were disconnected from TEV servers.
- d. As part of information security activities, phishing emails focused on social engineering have been sent at different times throughout the year to create user awareness. Results have been analyzed, and trainings have been provided along with user-focused measures. Reminders have been added to visual areas such as screen savers to raise awareness of information security.
- e. Server backup work was carried out under the disaster recovery policy.
- f. Multi-factor authentication was introduced in Office 365 applications.
- g. Penetration test has been performed. No critical or highpriority vulnerabilities were identified in the Foundation's systems as a result of the test.

TBY (TEV Grantees Journey) Activities

- a. Following the February 6 earthquakes, a special disaster scholarship application form was prepared. Through this form, 94,243 applications were received in one week.
- b. A Candidate Tracking Platform has been prepared where scholarship candidates can track the entire process of their applications online and instantly. A fully integrated application system was established by creating a personalized area where candidates can track the entire scholarship application process on the website.

- c. Elimination and ranking criteria were applied according to the information given by the scholarship candidate in the application form, and the Technical Evaluation system, which ranks all students based on school/faculty, was formed.
- d. Barcoded documents that can be obtained via E-Government were controlled and compared with the information on the application form.
- e. The International Scholarship Application Form has been renewed in line with the needs.
- f. As part of the digitization of laborintensive works, the students uploaded academic records and student certificates which can be obtained with a barcode from the E-government, to the system. The uploaded documents were read and processed by the system using OCR, RPA, and AI technologies. Using OCR, RPA, and AI technologies, adjustments have been made to the transcript reading system, increasing the number of readable transcripts to around 75% and the success rate to approximately 95%.
- a. With the Interview Platform, scholarship interviews are conducted on an online platform and the entire process can be monitored transparently. In 2023, improvements continued and the platform was integrated with the website and ERP system.

ERP Activities

As the first foundation in Türkiye to migrate all of its processes to ERP, TEV continued to improve its ERP systems in 2023. Throughout 2023, a total of 1,204 requests related to TEV ERP systems were answered. 134 strategic business, 15 revenue loss-preventing, and 41 additional revenue-generating developments were made.

Digital Transformation Efforts

The second phase of the TEV Grantees Journey Project was completed with the below steps.

Renewal of the Education

Scholarship Application Form: Several arrangements were made to enable students to access the education scholarship application form more quickly, to make the questions in the form more explanatory, so that students do not have difficulty answering, and to ensure better analysis of the results by adjusting the scoring system.

Reading Activities of Transcripts

and Student Certificates: Within the digitization of labor-intensive works, students' transcripts and certificates were downloaded via e-government and uploaded to the relevant field on the TEV website. Processing of the transcripts uploaded to the website was ensured, using OCR, RPA, and Al technologies. Thus, printing and shipping costs were reduced and resources were utilized effectively.

E-Government Document

Verification System: The documents, which are requested from the students invited for the interview can be obtained from the e-government with barcodes, are read by the system with OCR, RPA and AI technologies and checked with the information given by the scholarship candidate in the application form. Lastly, it is shown in the interview system whether or not these document are consistent.

Interview Platform: An interview platform system was generated to ensure that scholarship interviews are made online and through a single system, the results can be recorded and transparently seen by everyone, and the documents uploaded by the students and the status of the candidates are followed up. An interview appointment system was established to work in integration with this system. The interview time can be determined on the system and sent to the commission members automatically through the

Digital Archive

Data loss is minimized and a significant cost advantage is obtained with the digital archive transition, which provides simultaneous, uninterrupted, and fast access to the information and documents produced or obtained as part of the activities of the Foundation, and to all documents, such as the documents, the original of which must be kept.

Our Awards

At the Information Technology Summit '23, organized with the theme of Enigma, the "TEV Grantees Journey" project participated in the Technology Captains competition, where the best of the sector took part and more than 122 projects competed in 7 different categories.

TEV was the only non-governmental organization in the competition, which was voted by the public with more than 20,000 participants and the results were determined by the jury's decision. TEV won the first prize in the "Social Responsibility Project of the Year" category and the third prize in the "Digital Transformation Project of the Year" category.



PROJECTS FOR A BRIGHT FUTURE

TEV Youth Platform Obigenç was shaped with the pro bono support of McKinsey & Company based on the vision of "understanding the problems of young people better and making more extensive contributions to their lives."

TEV Memory to be Renewed with the Digital Archive Project

Digital Archive Project was started in December 2022 in order to classify and reduce all documents and files in the archive of the Turkish Education Foundation in accordance with archiving standards, to transfer important documents to digital media in an indexable manner with technology products, to guide them and keep them regularly by barcoding. With this project, which plays a key role in digital transformation of the foundation, archive and document management, data backup and recovery, safe storage and safe destruction processes were implemented with the Iron Mountain solution partnership.

The sustainability-oriented continuation phase of the project, which will be carried out in 2024, will continue to address the new storage and backup needs of the half-century-old archive of TEV, which is integrated with the Archive Management System (AYS). With the Digital Archive Project, over one million pages of documents were indexed and digitized, thereby enabling TEV's archive to be both protected with greater security and secured against force majeure such as natural disasters. The project outputs will also make it possible to access and search the digitized documents remotely when needed. Thanks to the New AMS, it will be ensured that necessary integrations are implemented faster and more optimally if there is a need to stratify the TEV archives with a Document Management System (DMS) in the future.

TEV Youth Platform Obigenç

Obigenç was shaped with the pro bono support of McKinsey & Company based on the vision of understanding the problems of young people better and making more extensive contributions to their lives. With this project, TEV went beyond the development of a "mobile application" that can be used by all young people, especially TEV grantees, and aims to be the first platform that comes to mind when it comes to applying for scholarships and to provide both personal development support and financial support to millions of students who download the application.

The main value at Obigenç is defined as enabling both TEV and companies to understand the needs of young people better and support them in various areas while allowing students to access all the support their financial and emotional needs throughout their university journey from a single platform. First of all, it is aimed to set out as a scholarship platform and to make students benefit from the platform through various sponsorships. At the final stage, in addition to financial support, the aim is to transform the platform into a digital platform where young people can interact with each other and create networks, reach various career and educational opportunities, and meet their needs.



REAL ESTATE PORTFOLIO MANAGEMENT

TEV ensures that the movable and immovable assets donated by philanthropists are turned into educational support for our youth, and acts with the awareness of bearing a great responsibility.

TEV acts as an intermediary for making use of the movable and immovable assets bequeathed by philanthropists, for education in Türkiye. Honored to function as an intermediary, TEV acts with the awareness of bearing a great responsibility, and is proud of the placement of a great confidence in the Foundation.



Within the framework of the 2019-2023 Real Estate Portfolio Management Strategy Plan approved by the Board of Trustees in 2020 and the 2023-2025 Real Estate Investment Strategy approved by the Board of Directors, the **Real Estate** Management Team has continued to work with the aim of increasing real estate revenues, increasing real estate efficiency by minimizing expenses, and providing resources for the Foundation's purposes with regular income from real estate.

In line with this aim, market values were monitored so that real estate did not lose value, and the real estate were

For the "sales, rental, urban transformation and project development" transactions performed by the Real Estate Management unit within the framework of legal arrangements and internal regulations, services of the independent real estate appraisal firms licensed by the CMB are received in the analysis of rental value, sales value and investment. Real Estate Portfolio value is based on the valuation reports conducted in 2023, CBRT Housing Index rates and market analysis researches.

ETHICAL VALUES

Real estate processes are monitored under nine main titles within the frame of legal arrangement, the Foundation's internal regulations and ethical values. In this context, rent increases were made in 2023 within the framework of the CPI 12-month rent increases announced by the Turkish Statistical Institute (TURKSTAT), while the legal limit of 25% for residential units was respected as of July. As per the Code of Obligations, a rent increase was applied to our tenants, whose market increase period has come, based on the current value of rents determined by the appraisal companies with CMB license.

CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENT

Solid structures for the future To maintain the value of our foundation's properties and the rental income they earn, a total of 141 renovation, maintenance, and repair works, including 92 maintenance and repair, 14 renovations and 35 risk management works were carried out in 2023.

Renovation, maintenance and repair works were performed to increase the number of classrooms in the buildings located in TEVITOL. Furthermore, solar panels were built on the roof of the Heat Center and integrated into the system to reduce the heating expenses.

Lastly, the works for the building, which was donated by the TEV benefactor in Kocaeli for the purpose of moving the Kocaeli Branch, renovating the building and providing training to grantees, were completed and the building was opened.

It is planned to be handed over to the Ministry of National Education for opening and starting education in the second half of the 2024 academic year.

Ankara Yenimahalle TEV Girls' **Dormitory Project:** Within the

The dormitory construction is planned to be completed by 2025, and it is scheduled to be opened for student accommodation in June 2025.

PwC TEV Primary School: Within the framework of the protocol signed with the National Education Ministry and with the donation of the TEV benefactor PwC, tenders have been conducted for the construction of a 12-classroom primary school in Saylak village of Kırıkhan district, Hatay province. It is planned to inaugurate the school during the first half of the 2024-2025 academic year.

Since the day it was founded, the Turkish Education Foundation operated under the supervision of the General Directorate of Foundations in accordance with the provisions of the "Repealed Foundations Law and Article 31 and the continuation of the Law on Foundations No. 5737, which came into force on 27.02.2008." In line with the principles of our foundation, our records and reports, which we keep meticulously and sensitively for all transactions, in accordance with the legislation, were prepared and presented to senior management for 2023 as it is done every year.

Efforts were made to ensure that all organs of the foundation work in full harmony in terms of budget management and financial discipline, and to implement common principles and regulations.

The financial obligations of our foundation and our commitments to our stakeholders have been realized by effectively following up with the support of the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) infrastructure. Auditors selected by the Board of Trustees made internal audit in the foundation in 2023. An independent auditing company also audited 2023 financial statements of the foundation.

The goal of increasing the value of financial assets by managing them in accordance with the principles of the Foundation was reached within the framework of controllable risks and with the optimum return target.





NET INCOME RATES OF THE PORTFOLIO



- The annual return of the portfolio, at 61.69%, has fallen 308 basis points below the December 2023 CPI figure of 64.77%. Real income of TL and foreign currency assets and stocks was 2,402 basis points below, 99 basis points below and 1,732 basis points above the inflation, respectively.
- TL assets yielded a return of 40.75% which is 1,242 basis points above the benchmark index return.
- Foreign currency assets yielded a return of 63.78% which is 610 basis points above the benchmark index return.
- Stock portfolio yielded a return of 82.09% which is 4,717 basis points above the benchmark index return.
- The portfolio weighted average return is 1,672 basis points above the benchmark index value.

The income and expense distribution of the Turkish Education Foundation according to the final budget of 2023 is summarized in the graphs below.





As part of the improvement of internal control activities, the Administrative Affairs and Procurement department has completed the process of conducting procurement transactions through work flow systems and creating digital archives.

As of October 2022, the administrative tasks have been transferred from the Human Resources department to the Financial Affairs department, and the unit continues its activities as the Financial and Administrative Affairs Group Directorate. As of 2023, procurement activities of all General Directorate units, except for the Information Technology and Construction Units, have been taken over. Support was also provided for purchases of economic enterprises and branches above a certain amount.

The supplier pool was expanded in order to reduce Foundation costs by obtaining competitive prices. Furthermore, supplier satisfaction surveys have been conducted to measure the performance of existing suppliers.

AUDIT AND RISK MANAGEMENT

Internal Audit Activities

In addition to the audit activities carried out by independent audit institutions every year, all activities of the Foundation are audited by the Internal Audit Department in line with the legislation and internal strategies, policies, principles and goals. Through the Audit Committee, the Internal Audit Department, which reports directly to the Board of Directors, strengthens the organization's ability to create, protect, and sustain value by providing risk-based, reasonable, and objective assurance, advice, insights, and foresight to the Board of Directors.

Risk Management Activities

Obligation to manage the risks identified during the activities of the Foundation from a broad perspective and with an understanding of sustainability is the primary subject which sets the steps of corporate risk management. With the works performed in a holistic template, taking into account the relations of risks with each other, a strategic and proactive model of the processes within the risk management is embraced. Detected risks are first defined. Their occurrence probability and their impact are analyzed and scored. Action plans are established to mitigate the effects of identified risks and related risks are managed within the framework of risk tolerance limits approved by the Board of Directors. With the internal audit activities, effectiveness and sufficiency of the risks defined in the risk inventory are periodically tested through the firstlevel control processes.
